CeMAT Special

Vollert showcases its automatic cranes for goods of up to 40 tonnes

Vollert Anlagenbau will be presenting solutions for heavy-duty automatic cranes at the CeMAT fair in Hanover from 2nd until 6th May, 2011 (hall 27, stand F52), with floor-bound and overhead intralogistics systems completing the range.

Practical examples are testament to the versatility and flexibility of the automatic cranes from Vollert: Whether in aluminium extrusion plants, steel production or for transporting coils and other goods, they always play a key role in linking internal processes. The ability of Vollert cranes to move materials off the ground allows them to command an additional dimension in production facilities, enabling them to securely transport loads weighing between 2 and 40 tonnes within very tight spaces. Other functions, such as rotating and weighing work pieces, accelerate production even further.

One example is the new 260-tonne automatic crane for the Vallourec & Mannesmann Tubes steel tube plant – the largest ever in Vollert's 85-year history. Two heavy-duty lorries recently brought both 45-metre long, 55-tonne bridge girders from the company's own manufacturing facility in Weinsberg to Düsseldorf-Rath, where they were assembled and commissioned. With more than 300 metres of track at its disposal, the crane can travel to approximately 200 pick-up and drop-off points. At CeMAT, Vollert will also be presenting a number of solutions incorporating floor-bound and overhead intralogistics systems.
